# DPW: Performance Goals

## STREET MAINTENANCE

**Maintain the cleanliness and quality of City streets and sidewalks**

- **SERVICE DELIVERY:** This presentation includes updated information for ongoing SFStat measures including 28-Clean Service Requests.
- **PROPOSITION C STATUS:** This presentation includes a status report on Prop C implementation for street maintenance, including data from testing the standard in July – September 2005.

# DPW: Prop C Street Maintenance

## Inspection Results

- DPW has implemented standards in compliance with Prop C
- July/Aug/Sept – DPW staff inspected routes monthly **BEFORE** and **AFTER** street cleaning and trash pick-up
  - Street Cleanliness
  - Graffiti
  - Trash Receptacles
- Sept – Controller's Office staff inspected routes **AFTER** street cleaning and trash pick-up
  - Street Cleanliness
  - Graffiti
  - Trash Receptacles

# DPW: Prop C Street Maintenance

## Inspection Results – new (cont.)

- The City selects one route in each of the 11 supervisorial districts for inspections.
- The routes are categorized by daily, every other day, and weekly routes.
  - Daily Routes are predominately commercial;
  - Weekly Routes are predominately residential; and
  - Every Other Day Routes are a combination.
- A sample of the routes, not the entire route is inspected.
