About This Database and User Guide

Format: Microsoft Access 2000.

The database contains data from the four key City departments that contract with health and human service providers and from the community-based organizations (CBOs) themselves. The information concerns contracts, cuts and effects of cuts for fiscal year 2003-04.

CITY Contract Data for FY 2003-04 (Screen I) contains information from the City about contracts held by nonprofit organizations that provide health or human services in San Francisco in fiscal year 2003-04. Only contracts with the departments of Aging and Adult Services, Children, Youth and Their Families, Human Services, and Public Health are included. *Those departments provided the data, which was not audited or otherwise verified by the Controller's Office.* The information was collected in January and March 2004, and does not reflect subsequent contracts or modifications to existing contracts. Excluded from this database is information about nonprofit organizations that contract with City agencies other than the four listed, service providers based outside of San Francisco, for-profit organizations and government entities.

Unit of Service (UOS) data is provided only for the Department of Aging and Adult Services' (DAAS) contracts. Most DAAS contracts provide multiple services and each service has its own UOS. For reporting purposes, UOS information has been aggregated across services. For example, if a contract provides for 100 congregate meals and 100 home-delivered meals, those UOS have been combined to equal 200 senior meals.

Survey Data by CBO (Screen II), Service (Screen III) and Summary Reports contain information that was provided by the 142 nonprofits that responded to the Controller's survey. With the exception of certain corrected totals, all survey data is as originally reported by the nonprofit organizations. Data for some community-based organizations (CBOs) may be incomplete if they did not complete questionnaires for all of their services. For the survey questions regarding actual and proposed budget cuts, if a cut to a CBO's funding was proposed and the cut occurred, only information on the actual cut is included. Only when a proposed cut did not occur is the information shown as a proposed cut.

SAMPLE SEARCHES

Below are examples of how to search for information in the database. From Screen 1 of the switchboard (pictured below), click the **CITY DATA by CBO** button.



You will then be asked to define the parameters of the search. You can choose to show all records or to limit the results.

Database Navigation

Row Height and Column Width

Some text may be hidden due to the row height or column width. To adjust the size, point to the row or column boundary you want to move until it becomes \ddagger , and then drag the boundary.

Sorting

You may re-order most of the report results by right-clicking in a column and then clicking **Sort Ascending** or **Sort Descending**.

Filtering

You may filter your results by right-clicking in the cell by which you want to filter and choosing **Filter by Selection** or **Filter Excluding Selection**.

To remove sorting or filtering, go to the **Records** menu and select **Remove Filter/Sort**.

After opening a switchboard item you may close it by selecting one of the two close buttons in the top right corner.
