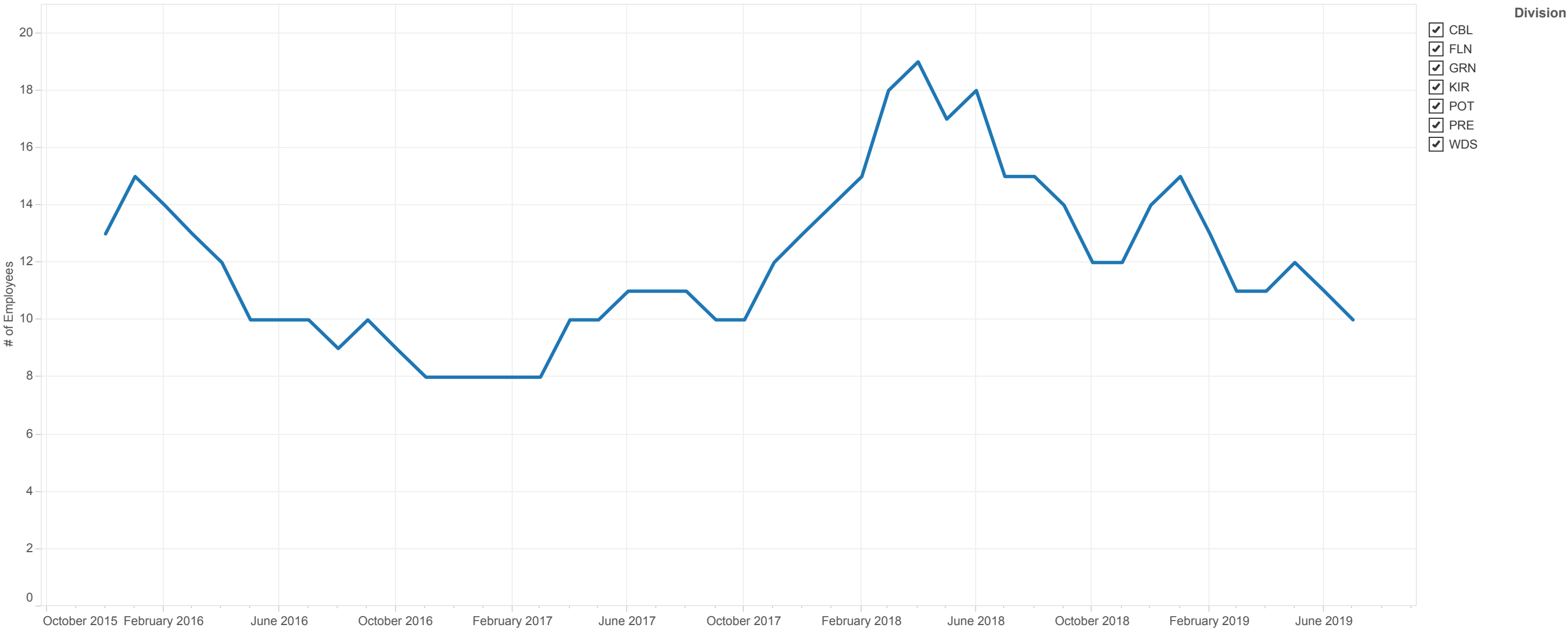


Historical Count of Operators on Worker's Comp for Over 2 Years

This is a distinct count of employees each month who have logged 730 consecutive days of worker's comp.

For the purposes of this calculation, a day on worker's comp means in HRDB:

1. the employee has a valid WCL or WCS leave on that particular date, OR
2. the employee's leave has expired for a LV_ID by that particular date, they have not completed the RTW process, and the last valid leave we have on record for that LV_ID is WCS or WCL.

The consecutive count resets if the employee logs a different leave type (i.e. TWP) on the next day.
